Students Win \$5,000 Youth and Philanthropy Initiative Award for Windfall

The Toskan Casale Foundation created the Youth and Philanthropy Initiative (YPI) for high school students in Grades 9 and 10. Groups of students choose a charity within the social service sector to thoroughly research and visit. They then prepare a funding request proposal. Through presentations, each group introduces its charity to their own class. One proposal is selected to represent that class in a subsequent intramural competition. The final element consists of each

class team presenting proposals on the charities they are championing to an independent judging panel. One finalist team per school is awarded \$5,000 from the Toskan Casale Foundation to grant to their selected charity. This Spring, the four brilliant students (pictured above) from Yeshivat Or Chaim Boys School in Downsview, Ontario were the winning presenters from their school. They presented the cheque to us at a formal day of education and celebration held by the Toskan


